CISC 110 Assignment 3

Each week from weeks 2 to 6, you will have a Flash assignment that's due. Show your completed work to your TA at the beginning of your lab. During the lab, your TA may ask you to explain to them how and where your assignment work uses each of the required features.

Note that each assignment will be marked out of 5 and is worth 2% of the final mark.

First, go over the following from the <u>Adobe Flash Professional CS5</u> text:

- Pg. 109-129 of Lesson 4: Adding Animation
- Pg. 282-289 of Lesson 7: Sound

You may work on these lessons to whatever extent you find useful before starting on the assignment (fully complete every step, just read them, whatever works for you).

Create your own Flash animation that uses some of the same features as the lessons in the Flash text to create an animated birthday card for someone who might enjoy it: your mother, a friend, ... For your birthday card, you may use any of the graphics and bitmaps from any of the lessons in the text (lessons 1 to 4 or later in the text) or you can create your own graphics and import bitmaps. If you know Adobe Illustrator, you could use it or similar software.

Here is a list of the features you're required to use:

- Create some MovieClip symbols
- Animate the position, scale, and rotation of objects
- Adjust the pacing and timing of your animation
- Animate transparency and some special effects
- Create a curved motion path for an object
- Add a sound file
 - If it's a music file, clip the end of it, so it doesn't play after the animation finishes.
